

First Things - December 2024

It's the most wonderful time of the year. Or wait, is it? It's no longer anything close to a secret that the Advent season (the 4 weeks leading up to Christmas) is often an incredibly *stressful* time of the year! There's the stress of buying Christmas presents, meeting with family you may or may not get along with, attending church and school and other functions, as well as keeping up with our normal daily tasks. And with all of these stressors, it can become easy, as cliché as it is to say, to lose focus on the reason for the season. Advent is all about looking for a coming, but it might not be the one you're thinking of.

Advent isn't primarily about looking forward to celebrating when Jesus came on Christmas. Certainly we do look forward to Jesus' first coming at Christmas. However, Advent is primarily about looking forward to Jesus' second coming, when he will return to earth and bring about the end to this present age.

If looking forward to the end of the world sounds a little bit strange, stay with me for a moment to understand why it's something so worth looking forward to: About 2000 years ago, Jesus came to earth as a little baby, no power or fame to his name. No one else was singing the praises he deserved, so the angels sang out in the fields to the shepherds. He lived his life for 33 years and then that little baby was a grown man being put to death by the government. Three days after his death, something very unexpected happened: Jesus rose from the dead. He proved that his claims about himself were 100% true; he was, indeed, God. Shortly afterwards, he went up into heaven.

Why did he do all of this? Jesus died, suffering for every sin you've ever committed. He died for the sins of the whole world. And he did it in your place. Now, even though your sins deserve death in hell, God forgives you on Jesus' account. Simply through faith in Jesus and his atoning sacrifice for you, you get to have a place not in the hell your sins deserve, but in heaven with God.

So why look forward to the end of the world? Because Jesus, who paid for your sins and won your forgiveness, is coming back! He is going to return to earth; but this time it will not go unannounced. Jesus will return as the King of kings to whom every knee will bow. Through faith in him for forgiveness, life, and salvation, you will be one of those to whom he says, "Well done my good and faithful servant." And he will make you a part of the perfect and everlasting kingdom he is going to create. There will be no more deaths, stressful deadlines, broken relationships, uncertain futures, or anything else bad. You are going to live forever with the perfect King. That is what Advent (coming) is all about. That is something to look forward to.
